YOFCI Commends the Commissioner for Education for swift intervention in the alarming incident in Comprehensive Secondary School, Ndiya.

Youth for Change Initiative(YOFCI) has commended the Commissioner for Education, Professor Ubong Essien for what it described as timely and proactive approach to issue of public importance. The commendation came after the Education Boss swiftly swung into action over the incident involving a student and a teacher, where a student was maltreated by a teacher in Comprehensive Secondary School, Ndiya in Nsit Ubium Local Government

It could be recalled that Upon hearing of the unwholesome incident, YOFCI strongly condemned the act, and immediately swung into action to ensure that justice is done, by joining Child Protection Network(CPN) to pay an Advocacy visit to the Commissioner for Women Affairs and Social Welfare and the Ministry of Education to beckon on them as strategic stakeholders to address the issue to prevent future occurrence of such for the safety and total well being of Students in Akwa Ibom State. During the visit, YOFCI in company of CPN interfaced with the Commissioner for Women Affairs and Social Welfare, Mrs Inibehe Silas while a report on the incident put together by the Team was submitted to the Ministry of Education for necessary action. During our interactions on the matter, the Commissioner for Women Affairs and Social Welfare promised that they will swing to action to ensure that the issue is addressed squarely as the safety and well being of Akwa Ibom children are paramount to the Governor, His Excellency, Pastor Umo Bassey Eno.

We are glad to see the swift and proactive intervention of the Honourable Commissioner for Education concerning the issue and for ensuring that the culprit is brought to book to serve as deterrent for others. His action is really commendable, and goes futher to show that the government of Akwa Ibom State under the Leadership of His Excellency, Pastor Umo Bassey Eno is well concerned and committed to the protection, quality education and well being of every Akwa Ibom Child.
